TRAVEL PURPOSE / OUTCOMES

Meetings with High Value Manufacturing Catapult and site visit to Sheffield Advanced Manufacturing Research Centre to better understand the successful UK model and its relevance to South Australia, especially the Flinders University Factory of the Future. It also provided the opportunity to identify opportunities for South Australian manufacturers to connect to the UK capability in specific technology domains and collaborative research projects.

Site visit to Babcock's Rosyth shipyard and separate meetings with its UK workforce development leads to learn about best practice approaches to advanced manufacturing in the shipyard and shipbuilding workforce development, skills and training. Relationship established that will benefit future skills and workforce development in South Australia.

Attended the Edinburgh Festival and Edinburgh Festival Fringe, met with Edinburgh Festival leaders, members of Parliament and Council and established relationships and partnerships that will deliver mutual benefits. An MOU between the Edinburgh Fringe and Adelaide Fringe that formalises the agreement to promote each festival, and collaborate to grow audience, artists and skills.
